CODE OF ETHICS

THE PROFESSION

I will, to the best of my ability, assist, promote and otherwise support the profession of Outdoor Guiding and make every effort to provide competent and reliable guide services in New York State.

MULTIPLE USE

I will support equal access to lands and waters of New York State for recreational, educational, and sporting purposes for all, in accordance with current land use classifications and restrictions established by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. I will promote conservation and a rational use of the environment on public and private lands.

THE ENVIRONMENT

I will subscribe to a professional standard of wilderness travel and low-impact environmental usage. I will acquire a useful knowledge of local natural history and the ability and willingness to impart this knowledge to my clients. I will maintain orderly, sanitary and environmentally sound camps at all times.

RESPECT FOR THE LAW

I will fully cooperate with all wildlife officials, law enforcement officers, private landowners and public land management agencies. I will abide by, and advise my clients of all applicable conservation and game laws, statues and regulations, and will not condone their violation.

EOUIPMENT AND SERVICES

I will provide clean, well maintained, serviceable equipment and gear that is adequate for all conditions likely to be encountered. I will employ competent and courteous personnel in sufficient number to adequately care for the comfort of my clients. I will offer reasonably well-prepared and balanced camp fare for clients and employees in keeping with the nature of the trip.

ACCURATE INFORMATON

I will accurately advise my clients of the factors and conditions involved in achieving their goals. This includes weather conditions, terrain, fish and game populations, and the equipment, physical endurance and skills required for the activity to be undertaken.

SAFETY

I will at all times provide for the safety of clients and employees.

TROPHIES AND LIMITS

I will never fill a clients game tag or limit of fish or game. Barring unforeseen conditions, all fish and game hides and capes will be prepared and delivered to the processor, taxidermist or to the client at the conclusion of the trip in a satisfactory and usable condition.


TRUTHFUL ADVERTISING

GUIDING AND "NYSOGA" IN NEW YORK STATE

Guiding has enjoyed a long and colorful history in New York State. Early surveyors and sportsmen needed help in traversing the northern wilderness, so they engaged the services of old woodsmen.

Many of these first "guides" were trappers, hunters or loggers who "hired out" to occasional visitors for extra cash. As tourism flourished, guiding became a full-time profession and resulted in the Adirondack Guides Associated being formed in 1891. Following World War II, the lure of the wilderness waned and the Association all but dissolved.

By the 1970's the public showed a renewed interest in the outdoors, but had difficulty locating reliable guides. Thus the old tradition of "guiding" was revived in 1981 when the informal New York State Outdoor Guides Association was formally incorporated.
